

How To Apply Backer To Windshield

1. Finish the inspection process on the NHOST unit. Once the VIR has printed out and is verified, cut the insert off the lower right-hand corner of the VIR (Fig. 1). Cut on the marked lines top and left side of the insert. Once you make those 2 cuts the insert will be the correct size. Check to make sure that the sticker number printed in the upper left-hand corner of the insert matches the backer you are going to attach it to.

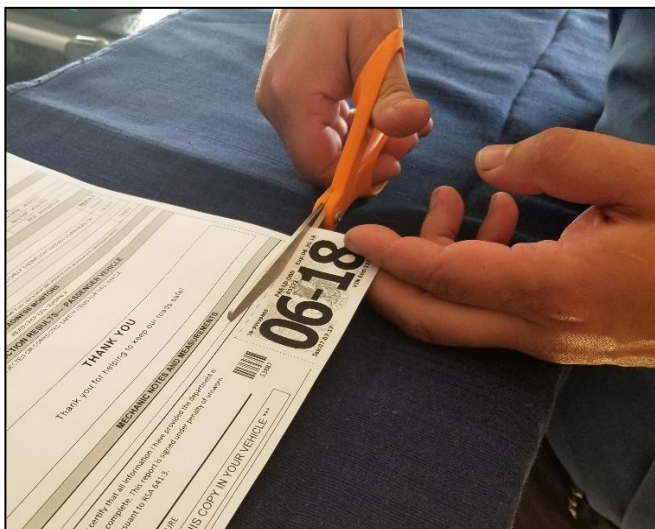

ATTENTION!

Read through all application instructions before removing backer from the liner.

The backer has several security features to prevent tamper and reuse. Some of the security characteristics allow the sticker to be easily damaged if mishandled until it is applied to the windshield. When instructed to separate the sticker from the clear liner always do so in a slow manner and in one direction. When applying the paper insert to the center of the sticker and the sticker to the windshield you will only get one chance to do it correctly as neither can be repositioned.

Continue to step 2

2. (Fig. 2) From the front side of the backer **slowly** peel the clear plastic liner from the center where the insert will go. Start in one corner, bend the backer back a bit and separate the clear plastic liner from the backer and completely remove it.

3. Carefully align the insert (Fig. 3) and attach it to the backer.

4. (Fig. 4) Separate the backer from clear liner by **slowly** peeling it off the liner. Once the backer is exposed, be careful not to allow it to touch anything before putting it on the windshield as the backer will stick to anything it touches, which will damage the backer and make it unusable.

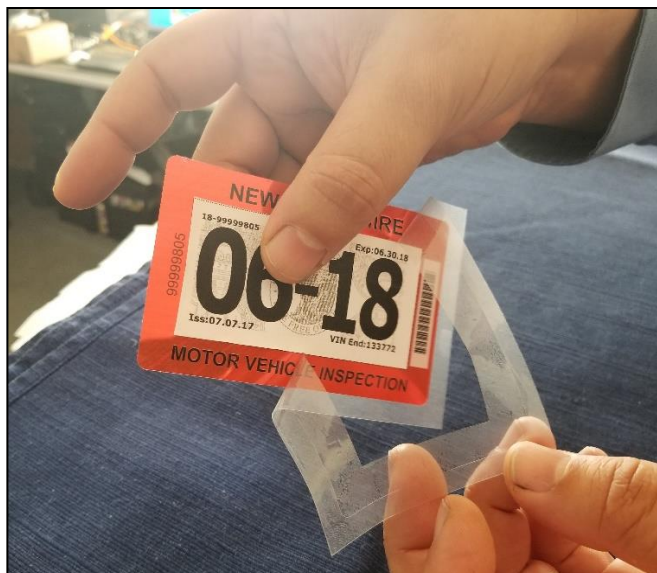

5. The sticker is ready to attach to the vehicle's windshield. Carefully position the sticker (within 2 inches from the bottom of the windshield and 2 inches from the left edge) and press it onto the windshield (Fig. 5) (To aid in application and reduce air pockets between windshield and sticker, rub from center of sticker toward the outer edges).
